





## Current State and Background

- **1970** Rail Passenger Service Act of 1970
- 1976 \$2.5 billion Northeast Corridor Improvement Project
- 1988 carried more passengers between Washington, D.C., and New York than all U.S. airlines combined
- Mid 1990s Federal dollars wane and states step up to fund or face cuts
- **2000s** Electrification and speed increases
- 2021 IIJA brings \$66 billion in rail grants




### Historical Ticket Prices for Amtrak







## Economic Analysis & Cost Proposals (ROI)

**Host Railroad Access** - More rail ownership under Amtrak control







## **Population Accounts**


U.S. Population growth of **130 million** since Amtrak was founded







## Policy Recommendations




Under the historic Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Amtrak received \$66 of the total requested \$75 billion dollars in requested funding.

More funding, education, and incentive are needed to further boost ridership and decrease dependency on cars in American urban and suburban areas.


British Thermal Units Per Passenger Mile (BTU/PM)
